

Puppy Care Information

- All puppies are whelped and raised in the house with us for the first 3-4 weeks until the weaning process begins. Then they move to the puppy house where we begin the weaning process.
- Puppies' weights are monitored weekly to ensure that all of the puppies are advancing at the same rate. Puppies are dewormed at 2 weeks, 3 weeks, 4 weeks, 6 weeks, and 8 weeks.
- At 6 weeks, the puppies are given their first shots.
- Pictures are taken frequently to keep everyone involved in their progress.
- We begin monitoring personality at 4 weeks of age.
- Puppy picks are made in the order that deposits are received at 7 weeks.
- I take pictures and video clips at 7 weeks, and I contact each client as it is their turn to choose their puppy. 7 weeks is the best time to see videos of the puppies to give a more accurate look at personality. The puppies are going through constant changes and at 7 weeks you will have a better pictures of what they are like.
